- He was born in Baix Camp (Tarragona) in 1852.
- He stated to be from Reus, although he also had family ties with Riudoms.
- He died in Barcelona in 1926, at the age of 74.
- Currently, he is known for 45 projects, including those built, those never built and those unfinished.
- 7 of his buildings have been declared World Heritage Sites by UNESCO.
- His most famous buildings receive 13 million visits a year.
